AGILITY TRAINING WITH GREG and LAURA DERRETT

As two of the top agility instructors, Greg & Laura Derrett conduct seminars worldwide covering all levels of handling and training in Competition Dog Agility. Greg has been involved in the sport of dog agility since the late 1980's whilst Laura, originally from America, has been a professional dog trainer since 1993 specialising in Agility since 2000.

Some of the highlights of Greg's long running, prestigious background: Greg Derrett was Great Britain's "Handler of the Year" for 1999 and 2000. His older Border Collie, "Jay", has won every major tournament in Great Britain at least once, and most of them twice. Greg's Border Collie, "Fern", placed 3rd as "Dog of the Year" in 1999 and 2nd in 2000 behind Jay. Complementing Greg's admirable training abilities, Greg completed an MSc course in Animal Behaviour. Greg is popular as a seminar presenter and has travelled to Japan in addition to Canada and the United States. In 2001, Greg and Fern were members of Great Britain's World Cup team for this special first time ever that England was represented at the World Cup. Greg continued to demonstrate his success by winning Crufts twice (including 2008) with GT as well as Silver at the FCI 2004 World Championships. Greg has also produced a very popular series of Agility Videos and DVD's.

Laura has been a professional dog trainer since 1993 and started her agility career in 1998 when she created her own agility centre, CDogsFly Agility in Turlock, California. Laura competed in the US with 3 her dogs, 'Josie' a golden retriever and 'Fly' and 'Fish', her two border collies. From there she moved to the UK where she has travelled around the world (North America, Australia, New Zealand and, Europe) giving agility training seminars. After Laura moved to the UK, Fish had to start again at the novice level and quickly progressed up to the highest levels in both Kennel Club and UK Agility. Fish has qualified and competed in the Singles Final at Crufts and the Agility Stakes Final at Olympia. He has also represented GB at the 2008 European Open and also in 2008 won the UK Agility Grand Prix Final. In 2009, Laura and 'Fish' qualified for the GB Team 2010 IFCS World Agility Championships. Laura's young dog, Spider, born in 2007 is just beginning his agility career and has quickly progressed through the levels in GB agility.

Greg and Laura represented Great Britain in the 2008 European Open and were Team Manager/Coach(es) for Great Britain's team at the IFCS World Agility Championships in 2006 and 2008. Both teams brought back an impressive array of medals and have been the most successful GB teams to ever compete abroad.

- Handlers working a dog may arrange for workshop co-participants to video sessions when they are working their dog but may not video other dogs, or Greg and/or Laura lecturing.

Auditors and Handlers with Dogs

- Auditors will be able to move between Greg and Laura's sessions.
- Whilst order of receipt of nominations will be taken into account, working places will not necessarily be allocated on first come-first served basis.
- Fees for Handlers with Dogs will not be charged to credit cards until working spots have been allocated. Cheque payments should be submitted for the full amount, they will not be banked until working spots have been allocated. If unsuccessful in obtaining a working spot the cheque will be returned or a refund made.

Lecture Details - Free for all workshop participants

Greg will present a lecture detailing his handling system, including key aspects such as the principles underpinning the system, positional cues and blind cross body line. This will provide both an excellent introduction for those who haven't previously worked with Greg and allow you to get a flying start into the practical workshops. It will also allow those who have worked with Greg to ask specific questions in a relaxed atmosphere and explore advancements in his system since the last time you worked with him. Whilst Greg and Laura will cover practical aspects of Greg's handling system during the workshops, Greg will cover the detail/theory of his system in the lecture that they will not have the opportunity to do during the subsequent days. The workshop content will be similar to that covered in 2009 however we strongly encourage previous attendees to come along as a refresher.

Single Day Workshop Details

Advanced Box Work Day

Topic Details: This full-day intensive workshop builds upon basic double box drills offered in the Basic Workshop, emphasising more difficult exercises and identifying handling inconsistencies that negatively impact your dog's performance. Drills move from advanced box work to sequencing and course analysis.

Prerequisite for Handlers with Dogs: Dogs must be able to sequence. Handlers must have completed a working spot in Box Work Basics Day (one of Greg/Laura's previous visits or one of the Box Work Days this visit).

Box Work Basics Day

Topic Details: Develop skills to improve execution and timing of your front and rear crosses, understand how to create positional cues, and build lateral lead-outs. Box work is also central to understanding Greg's handling system. Skills taught in Box Work will be built upon in all other handling workshops.

Prerequisite for Handlers with Dogs: Dogs must be able to sequence.

Decel, Accel and Turning Cues

Topic Details: Build your system of consistent cues to efficiently turn the dog when necessary on course - learn the cues available to you and how to execute them for effective handling of any agility course.

Prerequisite for Handlers with Dogs: Dogs must be able to sequence. Handlers must have completed a working spot in Box Work Basics Day (one of Greg/Laura's previous visits or one of the Box Work Days this visit).

Focus on Front Crosses & Rear Crosses Perfecting Position & Timing

Topic Details: Work on great timing and perfecting your position.

Prerequisite for Handlers with Dogs: Dogs must be able to sequence. Handlers must have completed a working spot in Box Work Basics Day (one of Greg/Laura's previous visits or one of the Box Work Days this visit).

Foundation Day

Topic Details: Foundations are the key to you and your dog's future success. Spend a day with Laura to learn how to create the best opportunity for success.

Prerequisite for Handlers with Dogs: Nil.

Multiple Day Workshop Details

Putting It All Together! How to make choices around the course in the Greg Derrett system. Timing and perfecting position. Learn to use consistent handling to tell your dog when to accelerate and extend and when to collect and turn. Course analysis, handling and body cues over two days so that you can progress your skills. The groups will get the benefit of instruction from both Greg and Laura on each day.

Advanced 2 Days

Topic Details: This workshop is for dog/handler teams *competing* at the ANKC Masters and/or ADAA Open/Advanced level.

Prerequisite for Handlers with Dogs: Dogs must be competing in ANKC Masters and/or ADAA Open (preferably Advanced) and must have completed a working spot in Box Work Basics Day prior to participating in this workshop (one of Greg/Laura's previous visits or one of the Box Work Days this visit).

Intermediate 2 Days

Topic Details: This workshop is for dog/handler teams *training* at the ANKC Masters and/or ADAA Open level.

Prerequisite for Handlers with Dogs: Dogs must be competing in ANKC Novice/Excellent and/or ADAA Intermediate/Open and must have completed a Box Work Day (with Greg or Laura) prior to participating in this workshop (one of Greg/Laura's previous visits or one of the Box Work Days this visit). This class is not suitable for dogs at Novice/Starters level.

Venue information:

Only dogs that have been granted a working spot (or by prior arrangement with the organisers) may be brought to the workshops. Please note that dogs may not, at any time, be left tied up. Dogs may be on-lead with their handler, or will be required (preferably) to be crated (or penned/suitably confined), when they are not working. Dogs that continually bark will need to be removed from the premises. **These requirements will be enforced.**

Qld - This is a grassed training field, with limited shade on the field itself, but trees around the perimeter. This venue is fully fenced.

Vic - This is a grassed training field. There is some limited shade (building verandahs and/or trees at the venue). There are various offleash venues however at this time of year, participants are cautioned to take due care with regards to snakes etc around water/dams. All group sessions/lectures will be held inside (in an air conditioned building however dogs may not be brought into the building).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY/PARTICIPATION

IMPORTANT – THIS IS A CONTRACTUAL DOCUMENT AND SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS

The undersigned who is a spectator or participant in dog training/competition activities conducted by Yunde Canine Enterprises ABN 76 699 077 212 (“YCE”) including but not limited to agility, flyball and obedience, in consideration of use of facilities and the right to view or participate in dog training/competition activities covenants and agrees as follows:

General Release. The undersigned hereby releases and waives any claims that the undersigned its heirs, successors, legal representatives assigns or estate may now or hereafter have against the dog training facility, dog training activity sponsor(s), YCE,, or its partners (Cathy Slot and Steve Drinkwater), employees, instructors or assigns (“YCE and Associates”) from and against any and all liabilities, losses, damages, costs or expenses of whatever kind or nature, including legal fees and indirect or consequential losses and damages (“Loss”), which the undersigned, children within their control or their dog or property may incur as a result of the undersigned’s activities (including the activities of children within their control or their dog) undertaken at said facility or participation in activities carried on by YCE and Associates including, without limitation, personal injury and damages thereof including loss of income, earnings, bodily injury, pain and suffering, emotional or mental distress and any and all medical expenses regardless of whether or not the loss resulted from the negligence or wilful misconduct of YCE and Associates..

The undersigned also agrees to assume sole responsibility for injury or damage caused by the undersigned, children in the undersign’s charge, or by the dog owned or handled by the undersigned during participation in YCE classes, events and activities and further agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold YCE and Associates harmless from any Loss caused or contributed to by the undersigned, children in the undersigned’s charge or control, or the dog the undersigned owns or handles.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK. The undersigned acknowledges and understands that the dog training activities undertaken involve inherent potential risk of personal injury and death to the undersigned or children within their charge and injury or death to personal property including dogs which may result from the undersigned’s voluntary participation in dog training activities. Such injuries may be caused by other participants or their children, spectators, other participants’ dogs, the undersigned, facility conditions including, but not limited to, the use of equipment, uneven or damaged terrain, the presence of moisture or mud, obstacles and obstructions upon or under the terrain and other natural or man-made conditions which may be hazardous to the undersigned, children in their charge or their dog or create hazards to the undersigned’s activities. The undersigned further acknowledges that these dog training activities are potentially dangerous, that dogs are potentially unpredictable and assumes all risk of injury or death and/or damage to the undersigned, children within their charge and their property including dogs which may result from any reason whatsoever.

STATEMENT OF BEHAVIOUR

I hereby agree to abide by the rules of YCE, including those outlined in any Workshop/Seminar/Class Outline and Booking Form, and agree that no dog shall be physically or verbally reprimanded while engaged in any activity sponsored by or affiliated with YCE, or while on the premises of YCE (with the exception of dogs committing acts of aggression towards people or other dogs or where such action is reasonably necessary for the safety or protection of any person, property or other dog).

I warrant that my dog(s) is/are not aggressive towards people or other dogs and that I understand I alone am responsible for the behaviour of my dog(s), that any dog, which is out of control, creates an unnecessary disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behaviour, may at the discretion of YCE and Associates be expelled from the event grounds. I verify that my dog and I are in good health, my dog is current on all vaccinations and health examinations and my dog is not on heat.

I agree to indemnify YCE and Associates for any Loss that results in any way from a breach of this warranty.

I will supervise, at all times, any children under 18 years of age accompanying me.

I will also comply with all reasonable instructions/directions by YCE and Associates.

I further understand that any violation of this agreement could lead to the immediate termination of my involvement in the event or activity (including being asked to leave the premises) without refund of any monies paid for that event or activity.

CANCELLATION/TRANSFER POLICY

If you wish to cancel/transfer your booking:

Handlers with Dog

Notice of cancellation received by YCE at least one month prior to the start date of your workshop/class:

- All fees paid by you will be refunded with the exception of the \$80-00 non refundable deposit.

Notice of cancellation received by YCE less than one month prior to the start date of your workshop/class:

- 50% of the total fees paid by you, other than the non-refundable \$80-00 deposit, will be refunded if, and only if, your spot/booking can be filled. If at the time of cancellation you have not paid the full amount payable for the workshop/class you will remain liable to YCE for 50% of the amount payable if your spot/booking can be filled or 100% of the amount payable if your spot/booking cannot be filled.

Request to transfer to an Auditor position (to the equivalent workshop/class) received by YCE at least one month prior to the start date of your workshop/class:

- All fees paid by you will be transferred/refunded (as appropriate).

Request to transfer to an Auditor position (to the equivalent workshop/class) received by YCE less than one month prior to the start date of your workshop/class:

- All fees paid by you will be refunded with the exception of the \$80-00 non refundable deposit, will be transferred/refunded (as appropriate) if, and only if, your spot/booking can be filled. If at the time of transfer you have not paid the full amount payable for the workshop/class you will remain liable to YCE for 100% of the amount payable if your spot/booking cannot be filled.

YCE will do the best it can to maintain an active waiting list, but it cannot guarantee that if you cancel or transfer there will be a waiting list and your spot/booking filled.

Auditors

Notice of cancellation received by YCE at least one month prior to the start date of your workshop/class:

- 50% of the total fees paid by you will be refunded.

Notice of cancellation received by YCE less than one month prior to the start date of your workshop/class:

- No refunds. If at the time of cancellation you have not paid the full amount payable for the workshop/class you will remain liable to YCE for 100% of the amount payable.

Cancellations/Change to workshop/class program by Yunde Canine Enterprises

- If, prior to the scheduled start date of the workshop/class series (ie all workshops advertised to be held in Australia by YCE and Associates), YCE has to cancel or reschedule the workshop/class you will be offered a refund, in full, for any amounts already paid to YCE. YCE and Associates will not be liable for any Loss caused by a cancellation or rescheduling of a workshop/class.
